In February 2019 Hatch contracted Saskarc for the supply and fabrication of the Mosaic K3 mine, South Shaft Loading Pocket Structural Steel. Saskarc's scope of work included:

- Structural steel connection design
- Preparation of detail drawings for structural and miscellaneous steel including erection drawings and shop drawings
- Supply of all materials
- Fabrication of 650 Tons of complex structural steel pre-assemblies and stick-built assemblies
- Trial fit of all structural steel confirm that the pre-assemblies are constructed to the correct measurements and specification so as when they are placed in their final location all interfacing elements between pre-assemblies, foundations and site built parts are aligned.
- Application of complex coating systems.
- Loading and shipping to the K3 Site, of all pre-assemblies and stick-built assemblies, inclusive of plate girders which were over 68 feet long.
